- **Only carry your day pack** and photographic equipment. Your luggage is transported to the camps. Bring only "worn in" light hiking boots - all other **equipment is supplied** (except photographic equipment).
- Enjoy **Tok Tokkie desert luxury**: A hot bucket shower & toilet with vista, delicious, freshly cooked meals and unique open sky accommodation. Lunch and three-course dinners are enjoyed out in the dunes.
- **Sleep out** under Namibia's stunningly starry sky in comfortable stretcher beds.
- **Small group** of min. 8 to max. 10 people for personal attention and tranquillity
- **Course Start:** Saturday 2.30 pm **Course end:** Monday ca 11.30 am

### What to bring

- Your camera (and instruction book) – don't worry what type it is!
- Something to clean it with and something to keep it dust free (a dry bag or a pillow case) as well as its case.
- Plenty of memory and spare batteries.
- A flash gun if you've got one.
- Something to rest your camera on - a small bag to put sand in, a light tripod or a leather hat!

### What else to bring:

- Curiosity and good humour
- Comfortable worn-in walking shoes
- Sunglasses, sunscreen and insect repellent.
- Light and comfortable clothing, Jacket and pullover for cool evenings
- Sport shoes for the evening
- A hat or cap is essential.
- Warm clothes in the winter months
- Anything else you might need but **don't overload yourself**, you want to be free to take photos!
